Program overview

Leadership Childersburg is designed to prepare leaders in Childersburg from all walks of life for an active role in community affairs. The participants will be comprised of leaders and potential leaders of this area. The program objectives are to develop an increased awareness of, and to provide a rationale for, involvement in current issues, opportunities and challenges affecting Childersburg.

Participants will receive an in-depth view of our civic and governmental leadership through face-to-face discussions with present community leaders and direct contact with the institutions that keep Childersburg moving forward. These learning experiences will accelerate the process of building a resource of community leaders.

Leadership Childersburg will be a unique experience for participants and will have an immediate, positive, and long-lasting effect on them, their organizations, and their community.

What Are the Goals?

Leadership Childersburg is designed to identify, develop, and build upon leadership resources in Childersburg. The goals of the program are:

- To motivate participants to achieve their individual leadership potential.
- To create the opportunity for participants to come to know, respect, and establish a rapport with each other.
- To bring together participants and current leaders to discuss the presentation and future direction of Childersburg.
- To challenge participants to greater involvement through volunteer roles in the community.
- To enhance the leadership skills of participants and improve their effectiveness in the community.
- To examine programs, agencies, and institutions currently operating in Childersburg.

How Much Time Will Be Required?

The applicant and CEO or immediate supervisor are asked to commit to the attendance and participation policies of the program.

In order to graduate from Leadership Childersburg, the participant must attend at least 40 hours of the scheduled program. In addition to the scheduled program, some outside activities may be required.

Participant Selection Process

- Applications are available to those who work and reside in the Childersburg area.

- Nominees should be individuals who have strong leadership qualities and who would contribute to, and benefit from, Leadership Childersburg.
- All nominees will be asked to complete an application form and return it to the Chamber of Commerce.
- A selection committee will review all applications and select no more than 30 participants. The committee will attempt to represent the full spectrum of agencies and organizations in Childersburg.
- Upon notification of acceptance, the **\$400 tuition** check must be received within ten calendar days or the position will be awarded to an alternate or other arrangements made.

Because of the need to represent the diverse agencies and organizations in the community, no organization is guaranteed a representation.
